- Introductions
- Minutes 1st Jim, 2nd Linda, unanimous
- 3rd annual Garden tour coming up. For maps visit ABoy, 7-Dees or Sweetness on Friday or Saturday.
- National Night Out (a city supported crime prevention event) Will be in Kern Park August 3rd. Need volunteers to help with:
- Keys for electrical box, Flyer distribution, Get entertainment
- If you would like to be on the committee star your name on the sign in sheet
- Last year we had local vendors would like to do this again. Required to live or work in FoPo. Contact Erica if you are a vendor or know of one.
 - Food is provided by Bar Carlo and Sweetness
 - Ideas for entertainment:

 - Foster Streetscape: Conversation is broader than originally because timeline has been extended. Goal is to make Foster safer and more friendly. Foster summit planning in Fall. The big issue is transportation safety. Please email Erica or John Mulvay for more information.
 - Ratification of spending: spent \$86 on FoPo bumper stickers, \$145 on magnets, balance held at Minute Man printing for later use.

 - Bank: Motion to remove JoAnn and Tracy as signers of the bank account and add Christian and Anna, Erica to remain as signer.
- 1st Jerry, 2nd Li unanimous
 - Representative Reports:
 - Library: New checkout machines up and running. Summer Reading Program starts June 18th. Participating children get game boards to track reading.
 - SEUL: Budget cuts to Bureau of development services means less inspectors to respond to reports of broken down cars and weeks. 3rd tier complaints like owner occupied weeds, boarded windows and disabled cars are a low priority. If you have a complaint keep a log of when you call.
 - Project 'Windfall': \$2,500 for Kiosk in Laurelwood Park. Some questions need to be answered before Parks and Rec will approve: Who will maintain? Will have a proposal ready for July board meeting vote once feasibility study is done. The Kiosk can be a place to show the neighborhood identity.
 - For July homework: Thoughts on neighborhood identity, what do we want identity to be?
 - Updates: Magnets and stickers are coming they will be here for National Night Out. Also want to have t-shirts available to custom order at NNO. Will try to have lap top for people to order there.
